House Bill 6112 (Binding Arbitration for Local Corrections Officers) passed the Michigan House of Representatives by a wide margin with bi-partisan support. The bill currently sits in the Senate Committee on Government Operations and Reform chaired by Republican Senate Majority Leader Mike Bishop (Oakland County). Senator Bishop does not support HB 6112 and is refusing to give the bill a hearing in Committee.

Discussion will center on the passage of HB 6112 and identify what must be done by Local Corrections Officers, both locally and in Lansing, to make binding arbitration a reality.
