



## 1st Annual Mason Samborski Memorial Golf Outing

Dear Sir / Madame,

Conducting a traffic stop early the morning of December 28, 2008 my son, Oak Park Public Safety Officer Mason Samborski, found a 16 year old driving without a license. Investigating the matter Mason took the teen to a nearby apartment where the parents were said to be. He soon determined that was not the case. The teen fled with Mason in pursuit, a struggle ensued down a stairway. Moments later Mason tragically lost his life shot in the head with his own gun by the teen. Mason was 28 years old.

From a young age Mason had an ambition to be a law enforcement officer. As a youth Mason settled in Brighton with his family. He graduated with honors from Brighton High School lettering in wrestling & pole vault. He went on to attend Michigan State University receiving a Bachelors Degree in Criminal Justice. During that time Mason also served with the East Lansing Police Department as a PACE Officer & Police Cadet graduating from the KCC Police Academy in Battle Creek. He subsequently attended the Schoolcraft College Fire Training Institute finishing at the top of his class. Mason served the community of Oak Park for 4-years seeing to the safety of its citizens with devoted honor to his law enforcement, fire & 1st responder duties.

Mason made his home in Howell. He left behind a wife & 1-year-old daughter, his mother, father, sister, brother, nephew, nieces as well as many extended family members, friends & fellow officers. The outpouring of support in response to this tragedy has been heart felt. It is inspiring to know that many hold deep appreciation & respect for our Public Safety Officers. Thank you so much to all.
