We expect to have an excellent turnout again! Highlights from the 2013 Walleyes For Warriors event include:

- Over 90 volunteer boat captains took almost 200 Veterans from Vets Park onto the Saginaw Bay for 5 hours of fishing.
- Over 1,000 walleye were caught, measured, weighed, and cleaned (Veterans took home their cleaned fish)!
- U.S. flags were flying along both sides of the river and military music played on the loudspeakers as crowds cheered.
- Sack lunches were provided to each fisherman. A catered roast pork dinner was provided under a large outdoor tent.
- Veterans were printed WFW t-shirts, given decals for their vehicles, and were provided with numerous donated gifts.
- Motorcycle groups gave a special honor to the Veterans. The Ogitchedaw Veterans and Warriors Society of the Saginaw Chippewa Tribe did a drum ceremony.
- Discounts were given at local motels and financial help was given for those who would have been otherwise unable to attend. Gifts of money were also given to some recently returned Veterans in need.
